

BETWEEN THE WIRES

In 1981, I approached WMUB (88.5 FM) about a short radio spot with news of interest to women that was generally not covered by the UPI and AP wires.

I gathered information from a variety of sources such as OFF OUR BACKS (a radical feminist newsletter), NOW Times (and additional information from the National Organization for Women), MS Magazine, and other newsletters to which I subscribed.

I titled the program **BETWEEN THE WIRES** for obvious reasons. I recorded these so they were 'in the can' rather than live. The segment was aired during the morning show. The last one was aired on May 3, 1982. I gave birth to my first child on May 2, 1982. Paul Dugus was the morning announcer/host at WMUB (the local NPR station) at the time and he announced that I had given birth to a girl and shared the baby's name! The program began in September, 1981 and ended in May, 1982.
